Poisonings



ND DOH, DIVISION OF VITAL RECORDS, 2004-2008

- Poisonings are the 3rd leading cause of unintentional injury death in North Dakota.
- From 2004-2008, 115 people died in North Dakota from poisoning.
- The 15-19 age group represented 4 of the poisoning related fatalities in ND.
- The 20-59 age group represented 98 of the poisoning related fatalities in ND.
- The 60-90+ age group represented 13 of the poisoning related fatalities in ND.

HENNEPIN POISON CENTER STATISTICS, 2009

- A total of 5,344 confirmed poison exposure calls were received in 2009 from ND residents.
- The 0-5 age group represented 3,221 of the poisoning exposures calls received in ND.
- A total of 1,902 confirmed poison exposure calls were received from 2007-2009 from Bismarck and Mandan residents.
