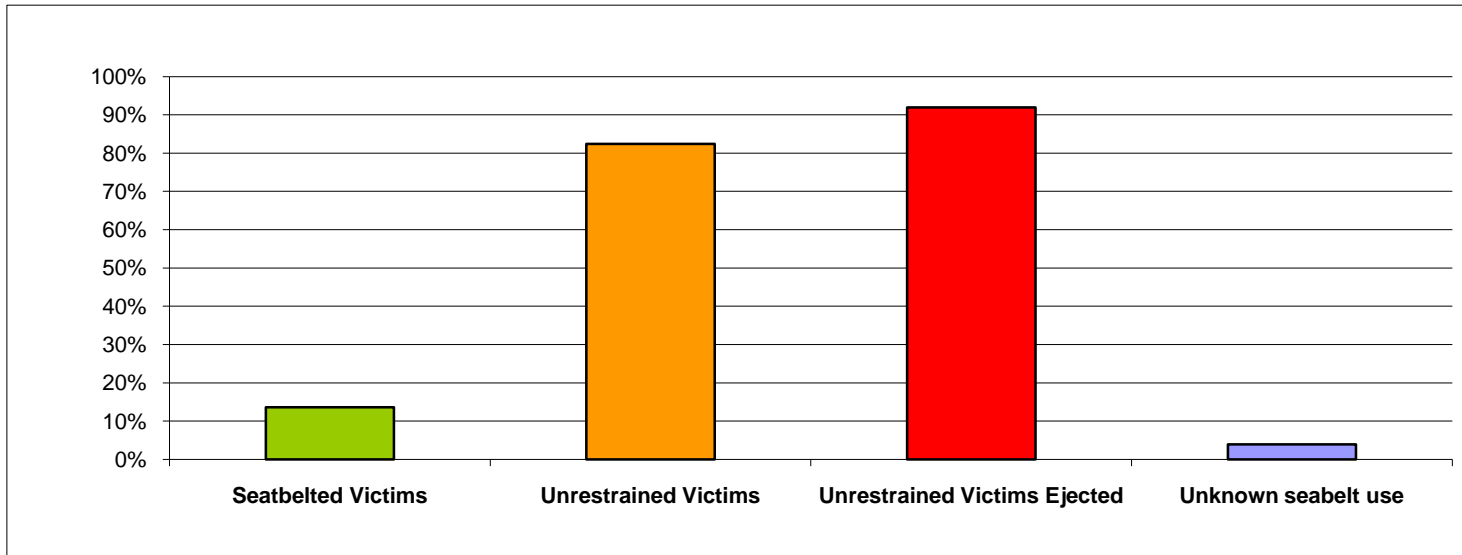


In 2010, 92% of victims ejected in vehicle rollovers were unrestrained.
