

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### WHAT IS THE DEFENSIVE DRIVING COURSE?

The Defensive Driving Course (DDC-4) is a fast-paced, four-hour driver improvement program, developed by the National Safety Council, that offers practical strategies to reduce collision-related injuries, fatalities, and costs. It addresses the importance of attitude in preventing accidents and reinforces the good driving skills you already have. Most importantly, DDC-4 shows the consequences of the choices you make behind the wheel and puts defensive driving in a personal context. This program teaches you a better way to drive that is strong, incisive and memorable.

### THE POINT/INSURANCE REDUCTION PROGRAM

This program is offered to North Dakota drivers as an incentive for their involvement in a driver improvement course. The North Dakota Safety Council, in cooperation with the Drivers License and Traffic Safety Division of the North Dakota Department of Transportation, North Dakota Highway Patrol and the North Dakota Insurance Department are pleased to offer you an opportunity to improve your driving skills, lower your insurance premiums and reduce your driving record violation points.

### THE POINT REDUCTION

After completing this course or Alive at 25, you will be eligible for a three point reduction on your driving record which could help you avoid a license suspension. It will not cancel a mandatory suspension or violation; nor will it cancel any action which is already being taken against your driving record. ## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### THE INSURANCE DISCOUNT

Complete an approved NDSC defensive driving course and become eligible for motor vehicle insurance premium discounts from your insurance carrier. Your discount may apply to all vehicles for which you are listed on the policy as principal operator, including autos, trucks, recreation vehicles and motorcycles. Contact your insurance company for details regarding their policies.
