SAVE MONEY, even in year one! Here are options for training and savings:

Scenario A - Private class for 100 = **Total cost \$5,980**
(plus travel time, mileage, meals, hotel)

Scenario B - Public class for 100 (member rate of \$80/student) =
Total cost \$8,000

Scenario C - Become a trainer and train your own employees:

• **Cost year one for 100 employees:**

- \$375 to take the train the trainer class (includes your trainer materials).
- Supplies to teach:

- 3 bags of manikins (15 total) = \$1245
- 100 Lungs = \$65
- Books and first aid kits = \$1520
- Epi Pen trainer = \$4.99
- AED Trainer = \$159.95

**Total Cost
\$3,369.94**

(Savings of \$2,610.06 vs private class)

• **Cost year two and beyond for 100 employees:**

- Renewal fee for instructor = \$40
- 100 lungs = \$65
- Books and first aid kits = \$1245

**Total Cost
\$1,350**

(Savings of \$4,630 vs private class)
