DUANE KUEHN OUTSTANDING SAFETY PROFESSIONAL

One award is presented annually to an individual who has been instrumental in the development and implementation of safety programs and honors those forward-looking individuals who, over the long-term, place safety and innovation at the forefront of their activities. Named after Duane Kuehn, who worked in the safety industry for 40 years and whose attitude and compassion demonstrate the characteristics of an outstanding safety professional, this award recognizes an individual within public safety who has gone above and beyond their daily duties and who exemplifies the mission of the NDSC.

CRITERIA

To be eligible, the individual must have spent 50% of his/her time directly on safety, for a minimum of 10 years.
