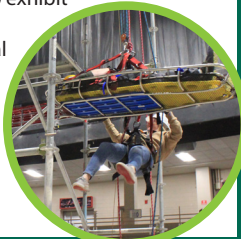

The NDSC held Conference number 50 in February of 2023. This week-long event showcased incredible keynotes, breakout sessions, and networking. With **160 sponsors**, more than 900 attendees, more than 100 exhibit booths and more than 50 speakers, this 50th Annual Conference left our team feeling proud, and more dedicated to our mission of preventing injuries and saving lives than ever before.



The NDSC proudly hosted about 500 people from the Bismarck-Mandan areas for Safetember. Held September 13, 2022, this event featured 17 safety partners with incredible interactive displays inside the NDSC building and outside, filling the parking lot. A North Dakota National Guard Black Hawk, drone rescues and active shooter demonstrations were just a few of the unique displays on hand. This event was a great way to celebrate 5 years in the NDSC campus building by showing off not just our team and our training, but the entire Bismarck safety community.

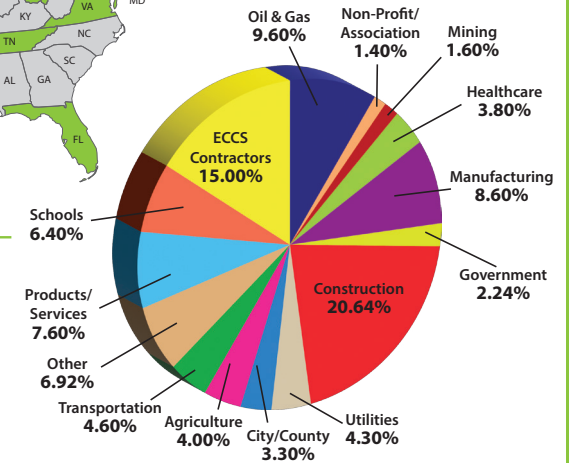
Membership IMPACT
