The employer shall have a written plan that includes preventative measures such as making a safety zone around your business or residence. (Within a 30-foot zone of buildings, remove combustible material and reduce the volume of vegetation to a minimum. Clear branches and shrubs that are within 15 feet of chimneys or stovepipes and remove vines from the walls of buildings. In addition to the 30-foot safety zone, an additional secondary 70-foot safety zone is recommended – increasing the distance between a building and vegetation will increase the level of protection.)
